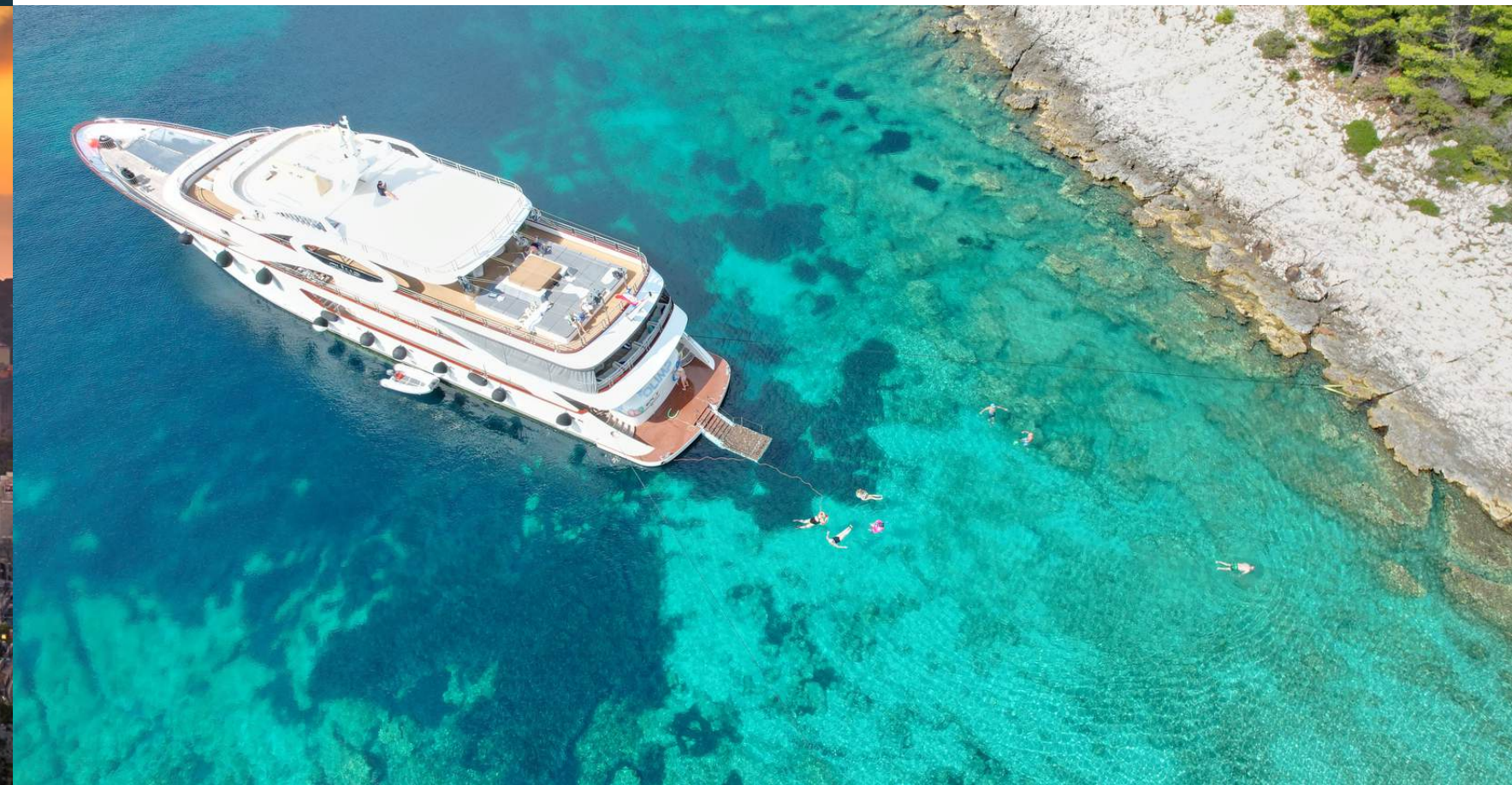

MAIN DECK

GRAND MASTER CABIN

Grand Master cabin [8], measuring 31 m², featuring a 180 x 200 cm bed, elegant interior design, and a private bathroom and walk in closet.

MASTER CABIN

2x Master cabin [6,7], measuring 20 m², featuring a 180 x 200 cm bed, elegant interior design, and a private bathroom and walk in closet.

VIP CABIN

1x VIP cabin measuring 16.4 m² [1], featuring a 180 x 200 cm bed, refined interior design, and a private bathroom.

TWIN CABIN

2x Twin cabin [4,5], each measuring 15 m², featuring 2 x 90 x 200 cm beds and a private bathroom.

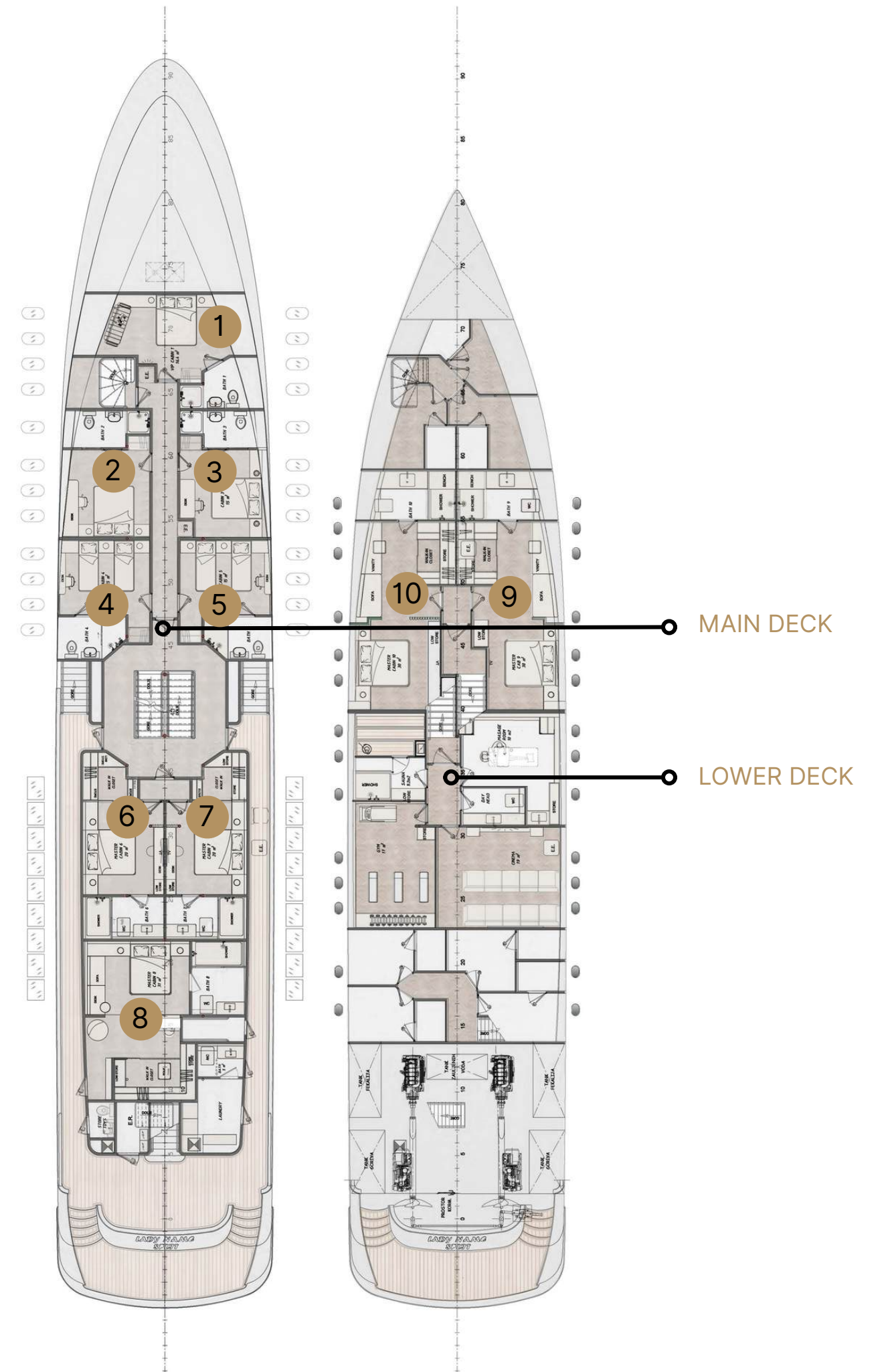
DOUBLE CABIN

2x Double cabin [2,3], each measuring 15 m², featuring a 180 x 200 cm bed and a private bathroom.

LOWER DECK

MASTER CABIN

2x Master cabin [9,10], each measuring 30 m², featuring a 180 x 200 cm bed, elegant interior design, and a private bathroom.



GRAND MASTER CABIN

Olimp's master-category accommodation includes three Grand Master Suites of 30–31 m² and two Main Deck Master Cabins of 20 m², all with a private bathroom, walk-in closet, elegant interiors, and a calm private setting.



VIP CABIN

The VIP cabin offers a refined and comfortable space of 16.4 m². With a 180 x 200 cm bed, it is ideal for guests who enjoy privacy and a calm onboard setting.

QUIET HOUR

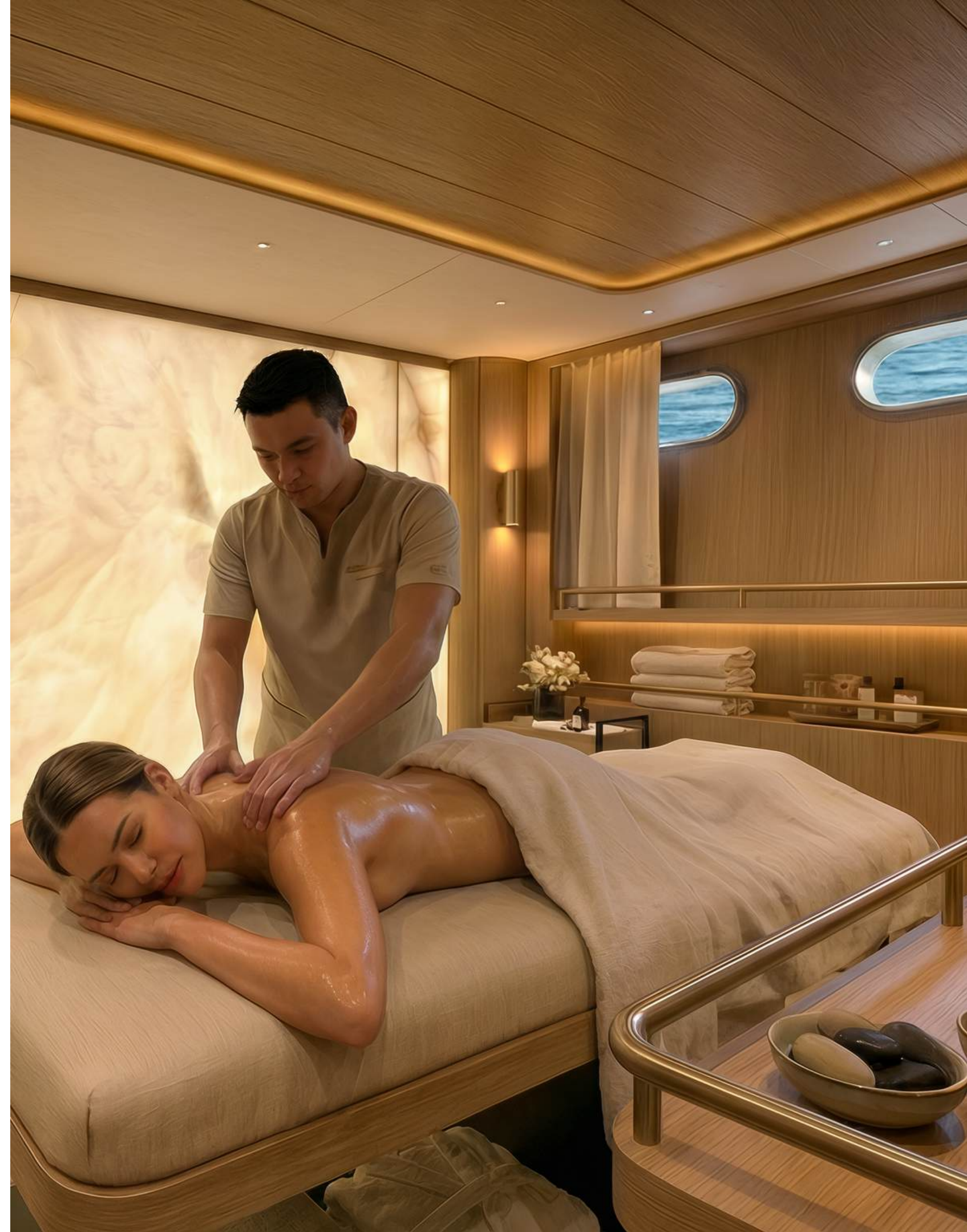


Some hours are for slowing down.

eFoil for the height.

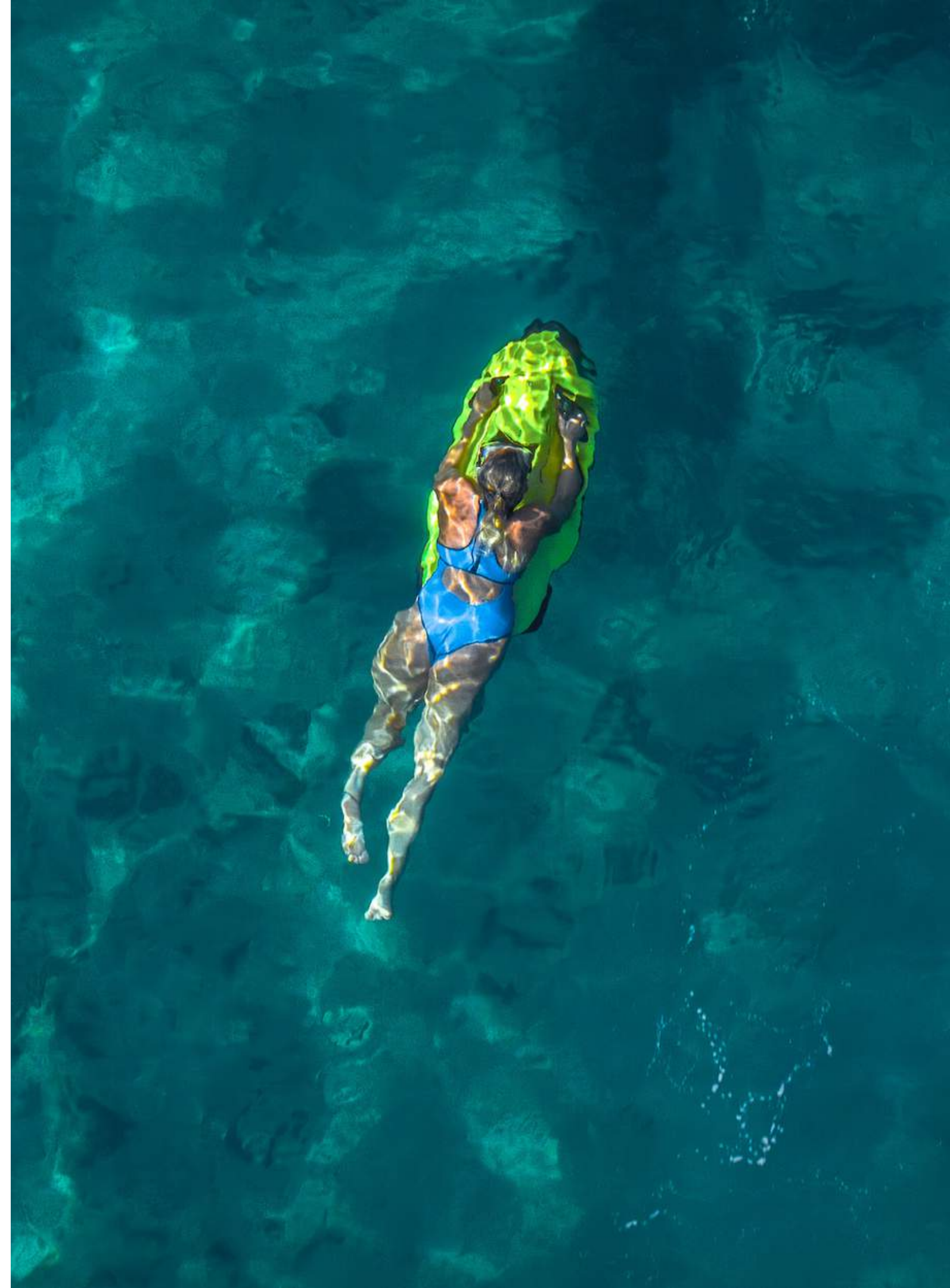
2 Seabobs for the silence below.

EXTRA PAYMENTS

Mandatory extras

A.P.A. (Advance Provisioning Allowance)

30% of the charter price: To cover the following costs, but not limited to: fuel for tender and water sports equipment; additional fuel for cruising (above 4 h per day), food and beverages for the Charter Party; berthing dues and other harbor charges including pilots' fees, local taxes, divers' fees, customs formalities, charges for waste disposal, charges for water and electricity taken from shore; shipping agents' fees where applicable; Charter Party personal laundry; hire or purchase costs of any special equipment placed on board at the Charterer's request, shoreside transport and excursions, national park entrances and other costs for services requested by Charter Party during the charter and all other costs not specified as included. A.P.A. is paid by the Charterer in addition to the charter fee for all relevant costs for the vessel that are not included in the charter fee. If A.P.A. does not cover complete costs, the Charterer will pay exceeding the amount on board in cash. If costs made on charter are less than the amount is given as A.P.A., the amount that was not spent will be returned to the Client at the end of the voyage. A.P.A. does not include a tip for the crew.

VAT: 13% extra on top of the Charter Rate.

Non-Mandatory extras

TIPS: Tips are not included in the price of the charter and are a voluntary way of showing appreciation for a good service. Usually it is 10% to 15% of the charter price, according to your satisfaction, paid to the captain at the end of the charter and distributed equally by the captain to the rest of the crew.

Delivery/Re-delivery Fee: If the vessel is not booked for the week before or after and starts or ends in a port outside of the home port, the charterer must pay a re-delivery fee, which is calculated based on the place of embarkation/disembarkation. For more information, please ask your broker.

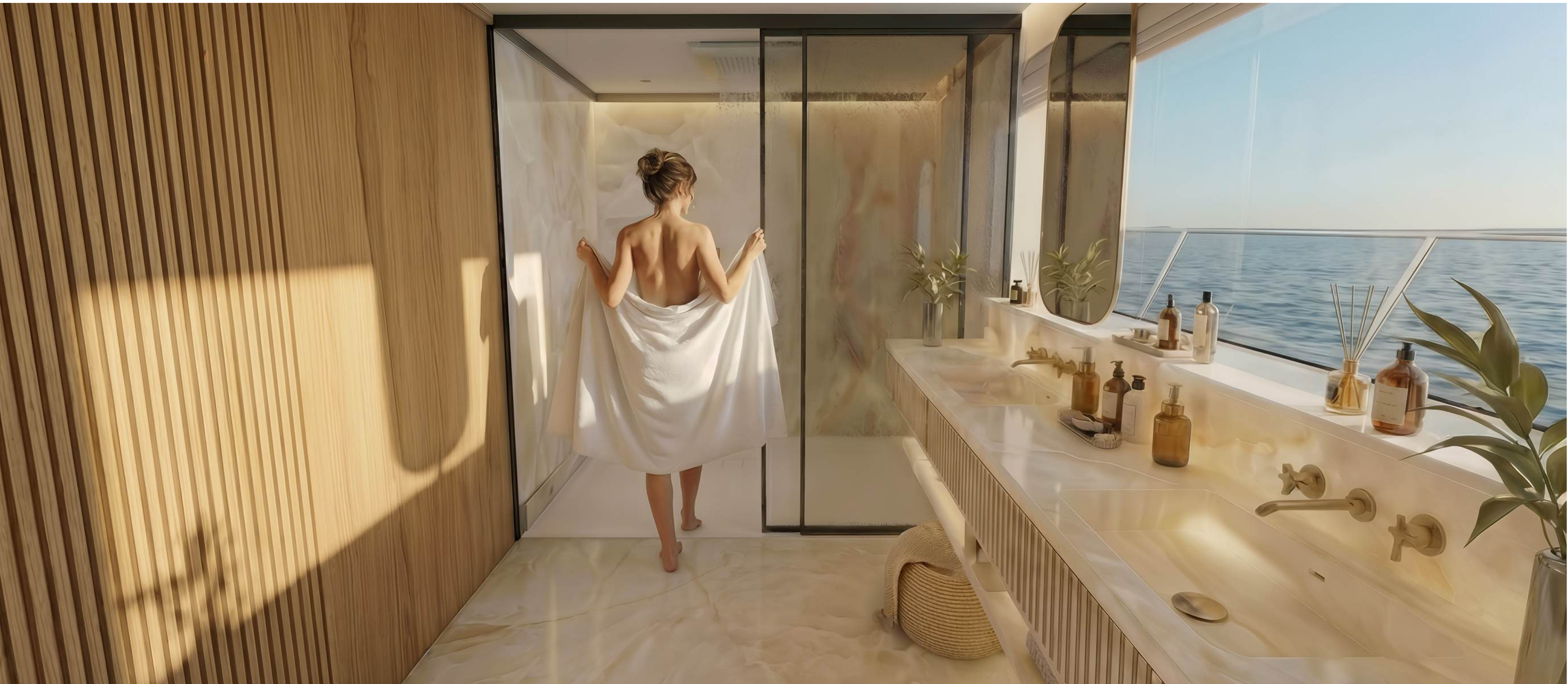
